

PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS

Dear Parents of Students in Grades 4 & 8,

The New Jersey Department of Education stresses to parents the importance of obtaining medical examinations at least once during each of their child's developmental stages (early childhood, pre-adolescence and adolescence). The development stage examinations should be done by the child's private physician and a report sent to the school nurse (N.J. A.C.6a:16-2-2(D)1).

In accordance with this recommendation, we require that *all students in **grades 4 and 8** receive a physical examination.*

For your convenience, a physical examination form and an immunization record form are attached to be completed by your family physician. *All students must have the physical form completed and signed by the physician, and returned to the school nurse no later than the first day of school.*
