New Procedure for Activities and Fundraisers

I'd like to tell you about a new procedure the HSA has implemented for many HSA-sponsored activities and fundraisers. This year, each grade will be responsible for the execution of one activity or fundraiser. I'd like to let you know how this process will work.

Here is the list of activities/fundraisers by class. *Please note that you are expected to help out in the class of your oldest or only child.* Of course, you may help out in other grades, too! Don't worry – the HSA will work with you each step of the way!

These parents will ensure that the activity/fundraiser is completed and that ***all parents in the grade participate***. For example, for the Halloween Party, two fifth-grade parents will chair the party. With the help of an HSA Board member, they will oversee the party from start to finish. They will ensure that all the tasks given to them by the HSA Board are completed so that the party will be a screaming success.

By distributing these events through the school, we hope to gain more involvement from all families. Please know that these events all take place outside of school hours, so all families should be able to contribute time.
